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Доклад по теме «Речевая разминка на уроках английского языка в старших классах».

Подготовила учитель английского языка Брейш Елена Вячеславовна Не секрет, что обучение иностранным языкам рассматривается как обучения коммуникативной деятельности и умению общаться. Но для большинства иностранный язык — ценность потенциальная, а не реальная. Для многих обучающихся урок является единственной возможностью применить знания иностранного языка в процессе общения. Поэтому внимание учителей должно быть постоянно направлено на совершенствование урока иностранного языка, на повышение его эффективности и доступности.

Одним из возможных способов, как показывает практика, является речевая разминка. Это такой этап урока, на котором осуществляется подготовка обучающихся к изучению основного материала. Он может включать игровые задания, ответы на вопросы, а также предварительное обсуждение темы. Речевая разминка — это комплекс упражнений, предназначенный для активизации речевого общения на уроке, создания мотива для речевой деятельности и снятия напряжения у обучающихся.

Разминка — это чрезвычайно полезный и «работающий» инструмент для начала занятий на энергичной ноте, помогает «запустить урок», а также отличный способ для того, чтобы заставить класс думать на английском. Важно, чтобы эти разминки заставляли учеников как можно больше использовать язык.

Этап речевой разминки предусмотрен для начала урока и длится примерно 10-12 минут. Регулярное проведение речевой разминки позволяет повторить и прочно усвоить лексику предыдущих уроков, закрепить в памяти школьников грамматические структуры и речевые обороты, овладеть навыком диалога, умением задавать вопросы, кратко и лаконично отвечать на них.

К сожалению, многие из учителей избегают проведения речевой разминки, опасаясь, что в этом случае не хватит времени на изучение основного материала урока. И напрасно! Для многих обучающихся разминка является инструментом мотивации и ситуацией успеха. Разминка даёт возможность сформировать умение вести непринужденную беседу при встрече. А ведь это может пригодиться в жизни, особенно если ребята планируют путешествовать.

Стоит напомнить, что говорение вызывает у обучащихся большие затруднения. Самостоятельное и почти свободное выражение мыслей на иностранном языке предполагает сформированное умение строить и прогнозировать всё сообщение в целом. Таким образом, речевая разминка на уроке английского языка является способом обучения спонтанной речи учащихся.

Как можно использовать речевую разминку в качестве средства обучения неподготовленной речи?

На старшей ступени обучения речевая разминка в основном служит тренировкой полученных знаний и умений. Регулярное проведение речевой зарядки позволяет обучащимся повторить в речи активную лексику, новые грамматические структуры и речевые обороты; развивать умение неподготовленного монолога, а также умение задавать разного типа вопросы и точно отвечать на них.

Но важно помнить, что речевая разминка, не связанная с последующим ходом урока, теряет смысл. Необходимо сделать так, чтобы она не была самостоятельным элементом, а стала введением в урок.

К задачам речевой разминки относятся:

- мотивирование учащихся к говорению на иностранном языке
- актуализация в речи учащихся изученного на предыдущих уроках языкового материала
- вовлечение учащихся в активную мыслительную деятельность
- развитие творческого мышления у учащихся
- развитие воображения и творческого мышления
- активизация внимания учащихся
- создание динамичной атмосферы урока
- развитие спонтанной речи учащихся.

Не стоит забывать, что чтобы речевая разминка была успешной и результативной, нужно соблюдать определённые правила.

- Разработать такое начало урока, которое вызывает у учащихся желание говорить по-английски.

Раньше речевая разминка включала в себя разговор о дате, погоде, о наличии отсутствующих. Однако, это является лишь повторением заученных ранее фраз и не помогает настроить учащихся на общение, что является целью обучения языку. Разминка должна быть интересной, вовлекать в процесс изучения иностранного языка.

Разминка должна быть «аутентичной», не оторвана от реальности, имитировать жизненные ситуации и то, что мы делаем каждый день

- Связать речевую разминку с задачами урока и его этапами.

Разминка должна основываться на цели урока, исходить из целей, поставленных перед собой учителем.

Следовательно, содержание и форма речевой разминки зависят от:

- цели урока
- уровня знаний учащихся
- учебного материала
- особенностей физического и эмоционального состояния учащихся.

Мною была создана «копилка» речевых разминок для старших классов.

Собранные видео, вопросы для размышления, упражнения для активизации лексического и грамматического материала были разделены на группы и распределены по модулям УМК Spotlight-10.

Каждая группа состоит из трёх разминок: лексико-грамматические упражнения, вопросы на рассуждение и видеоролик для последующего обсуждения.
