

What is it?

We use it to say we **see**,
hear, or **want** someone to
do something.

With see / hear

Formula: Subject + see/hear +

Object + Verb (without 'to!')

*No one saw Andy **leave** the house.*

With want / would like

Formula: Subject + want + Object +

to + Verb

*I want you **to listen** carefully.*
